Since the late 1930's, three generations of the Madrigal family have farmed some of Napa Valley's finest vineyards. The family history is a constant source of inspiration, and guides us in our wine making now. We value the long relationship we've had with the land and the people here, believing that the combined wisdom of the folks who've been here for generations and a deep appreciation of these vineyards can be tasted in our wine. Today, the company is run by Chris Madrigal, the founder's grandson, and vintner of Madrigal Family Winery.

Variety: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting notes: An easy drinking Napa Valley Cabernet. Dark fruit, juicy cherry and earthy aromas intermingle with a hearty core of cassis and black cherry flavors.



Domaine des Pasquiers Côtes du Rhône Villages Sablet 2018

Four generations of winegrowers have succeeded on this estate since 1935. This traditionally-styled winery is now run by the two brothers, Jean-Claude and Philippe Lambert and his son, Matthieu. Both complementary and conniving, they share the same values: respect of the soil, respect of the vines. They work tirelessly to craft elegant wines that are a true expression of this wonderful terroir. Everything starts in the vineyard, that's why they switched to organic farming. It is of course the love of this land and the passion for their vineyards that led the Lambert family, after careful management of the vineyard, to gradually convert the whole field into organic farming since 2010.

Varieties: 60% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre

Tasting notes: Color is deep red. The nose is subtle and aromatic with small black fruits. The tannic structure is strong: she gives to the wine a nice length in mouth.
